The program is aimed at participants from the agricultural educational sphere of teachers and trainers, human resource and social managers and will introduce them to a pool of knowledge and skills. It is a unique opportunity to network and establish educational partners from the multitude of different situations in Africa. The program was designed to include seminars, work-groups, group reporting, group assignments, demonstrations, educational and recreational excursions and informal social events.

SEMINAR VENUE

ELSENBURG, situated 13 km north of Stellenbosch, is the focal point of the Department of Economic Affairs, Agriculture and Tourism in the Western Cape, and offers a wide range of development and support services to the agricultural sector. In 1898 the government bought the farm for the use of an agricultural school for young farmers. In that year 22 students enrolled and this was the beginning of scientific agricultural training in the country. Currently Elsenburg accommodates the Agricultural College and the Western Cape Department of Agriculture's administrative headquarters.

Today the College accommodates 250 residential agricultural students per year. The Kromme Rhee training center forms part of Elsenburg. Agronomy and pasture technology, large and small stock science, viticulture, vegetable production and pomology are the major subjects in the Higher Certificate, which stretches over a two-year period. A diploma in agriculture can be obtained after the completion of a further year's study. The diploma in wine technology is very popular amongst perspective winemakers.

Because Elsenburg's training programmes emphasize the management aspects of practical farming, prospective farmers, farm workers, farm managers and agricultural extension officers mostly attend these programmes.

AIM of the SEMINAR

The objectives of the seminar will be:

- ◆ To expose African teachers and educationist to the pool of knowledge and skills of world-renowned educationists. It will assist them in their challenge to educate the local people to such a level of excellence that it will improve their quality of life to such an extend that they will cope with the demands of life in their respective countries.
- ◆ To enhance networking amongst educationists in Africa as well as the rest of the world.
- ◆ To improve communication between the different role players in education so that they can get to grips with the different situations in African countries and learn from one another.
- ◆ To expose a greater percentage of African people to the excellent educational opportunity presented by the CIEA.
- ◆ To expose the experts in education from abroad to hands-on experience of the African situation. This experience can only enhance their much-appreciated contribution towards educational excellence to Africa.

## TRANSPORT

## ENTRY VISAS

## GENERAL

The official language of the Seminar will be English.

The South African unit of currency is the Rand (R). Several Forex Bureaus are available at the airport and in the Stellenbosch business areas.

The western Cape is not in a malaria endemic area but travellers intending to visit the Mphumalanga area are advised to take preventative prophylactics against malaria. Medical insurance should be arranged privately by the participants, at their own expense.
